

HoustonSSC Oktoberfest Olympiad

General:

- Players are expected to know the rules and behave in an honest and sportsmanlike fashion.
- Officials may be consulted for rule interpretations or to make complaints regarding the conduct of other players.
- All rulings made by officials are final.
- Officials hold the right to eject a player or team for excessive/intentional violations or unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not required at any time.
- Teams will receive points for each event based on their score/time for that event, and the points will be summed up after all events are complete to determine the overall 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners.

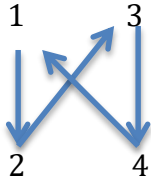
Brat Toss Rules

Equipment:

- 1 bratwurst

Rules:

- Players will begin 2 to a side spaced 10 feet apart and toss their brat in the order shown below. If all 4 tosses are completed, players 1 & 3 will move back 10 feet and begin their next level of tosses.



- Each player must stay behind their designated line when throwing or catching their brat. If a player steps across their line when throwing or catching the brat, the turn will be considered over and the throw will not count.
- If the brat touches the ground or breaks into 2 pieces, the team's turn is over. (Note: A brat that breaks but is still intact in 1 piece is still in play)
- The total number of completed tosses will be recorded by the official.

Barrel Roll Rules

Equipment:

- 1 empty keg
- 2 cones

Rules:

- This event will take place in a relay format.
- Player one will begin with their keg completely behind the start line (indicated by a cone).
- They will roll their keg 40 feet around the end line cone and return it past the start line cone, at which point their teammate will begin their turn.
- Each cone must be cleared in a clockwise fashion, i.e. each player will begin on the left side of the start line cone and end on the right side of the start line cone.
- Each cone must be cleared before proceeding to the next player.
- If a cone is touched by the keg or the player, a 1 second penalty will be enforced for each cone that is contacted, and the cone must be placed back in its original place prior to the next player beginning their turn.
- Once all 4 players have completed their turn, the team's time minus any time deductions will be recorded by the official.

Bucket Race

Equipment:

- 1 water reserve
- 1 bucket
- 4 steins

Rules:

- Each turn will consist of a 60 second timed heat.
- The course will be set at 80 feet in length and broken into 4 – 20 foot sections
- Each player will start with 1 empty stein, and will occupy 1 section.
- Each player must stay completely within the boundaries of their section.
- The 1st player will fill their stein from the water reserve and transport it to the boundary of the 2nd player's section and pour the contents into the 2nd player's stein. The 2nd player will then transport the contents of their stein to the boundary of the 3rd player's section and pour the contents into the 3rd player's stein. The 3rd player will transport the contents of their stein to the boundary of the 4th player's section and pour the contents into the 4th player's stein. The 4th player will then pour the remaining water in their stein into the bucket.
- The players will be continuously working together for 60 seconds to try and fill their bucket with as much water as possible.
- At the end of the 60 seconds, the official will measure the height of the water in their buckets (in millimeters) and record their score.

Stein Race

Equipment:

- 6 steins

Rules:

- This event will take place in a relay format.
- Player one will begin by picking up 6 steins filled with water off the table at the start line.
- They will then transport the steins 50 feet around the end line cone and place all 6 steins back on the table, at which point their teammate will begin their turn.
- Once all 4 players have completed their turn, the referee will inspect the water level of each stein, which have been pre-marked with lines to indicate time deductions.
- Each pre-marked line that is above the water line on each stein will result in a 1 second penalty.
- Each team's time (minus deductions) will be recorded as their score for the round.
